

# Bushfire Recovery

## small on-farm grants



## Overview

Northern Tablelands Local Land Services is delivering bushfire recovery small on-farm grants. Grants are offered to support farmers, land managers and community groups to implement local projects for weed control and pest control, animal welfare and veterinary services in bushfire impacted areas in the Northern Tablelands.

## What funding is available?

(Max \$25,000 for each grant)

**Classifications of grants available are:**

- Small scale on-farm demonstrations
- On-farm projects

## Eligible project activities

**Activities (including small on-ground works projects) that improve capacity to:**

- Manage weeds
- Control and manage pest animals
- Improve or rebuild facilities or equipment for safe handling and management of livestock and bushfire recovery.

## Who is eligible for funding?

- Individual farmers and land managers in the Northern Tablelands region\*
- Community groups and organisations in the Northern Tablelands region\*
- Groups of landholders (this may include producer groups, Landcare groups, neighbouring landholders working together etc.) in the Northern Tablelands region\*

## What is the process?
